We offer a free pickup service for bus and cruise ship passengers and crew from Port Chalmers.

RIDING LESSONS

- Take about an hour depending on the age and ability of the rider.
- They are usually one on one but we can cater for small groups if required.
- All riding gear is supplied if necessary.
- Lessons for first-timers to experienced riders in flatwork and cross country.
- Regular riders get a price discount.
- Corporate groups and children's parties are welcome.

HILL RIDE (1.5 to 2 Hours)

Enjoy stunning harbour views. We take a leisurely circuit through farmland and plantation, then back down the winding farm track. Refreshments are provided en route. A safe, rewarding ride for beginners. Perfect for beginners or experienced riders.

BEACH RIDE (Approximately 3 hours)

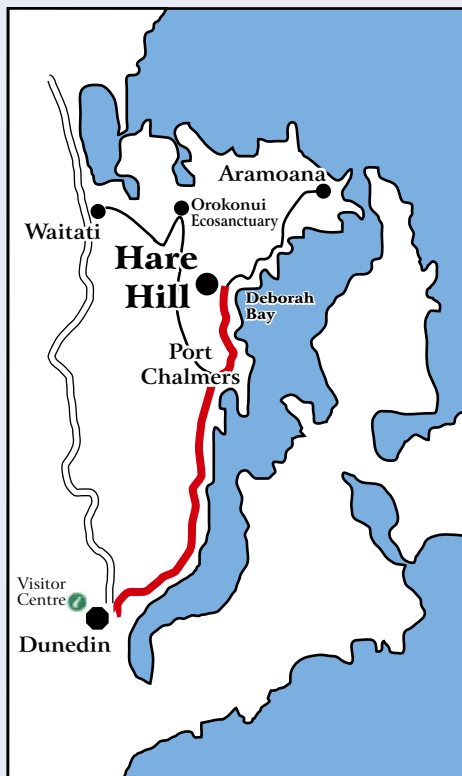

You may view wildlife on horseback, including seals, sea lions and penguins. Advanced riders will relish the opportunity to gallop along the white sands of the shore.

At the Port Chalmers Container Terminal turn left and follow the road beside the harbour to the far side of Deborah Bay where you will see our sign "Hare Hill Horse Treks".
